With the health and safety of all our dancers, coaches, and fans in mind, DTU has created an all-new regional format: the Hybrid Regional Competition. These hybrid events combine in-person recording sessions and a virtual, live-streamed show that will be judged on video and air approximately one week after the in-person filming! All regional competitions scheduled for 2020 will be Hybrid Regional Competitions. Regional competitions scheduled for 2021 may have the opportunity to transition to our traditional regional format. HEALTH & SAFETY AT DTU HYBRID REGIONAL COMPETITIONS

Teams competing at a Hybrid Regional Competition will be scheduled for a recording session where they will either be the only program on site or will share their session with one other team. Groups will be given a designated changing area and holding space so that if two teams share a recording session, they will not be required to come within 6 feet of each other at any time throughout the session.

Each team will record all of their routines in one session, so there will be no need to leave the event and then return later.

DTU will clean and sanitize the venue in between each recording session. There will be a sanitizing station for dancers and coaches to use at check-in, as well as before and after entering the performance area.

No spectators will be permitted at the on-site portion of these events to limit personnel on site. DTU will operate with a limited staff. Everyone will be required to wear masks on site including dancers, coaches, DTU staff, and volunteers. Dancers may remove masks if permitted by their school, school district and/or state activities association or similar body only while their routine is being recorded. Social distancing will be encouraged.

Coaches and dancers will be able to shop at the DTU store onsite, however, no cash will be accepted at the DTU store. An online store will also be available for parents, fans, coaches and dancers. Whether any concessions (water, other drinks, and pre-packaged snacks) will be offered at hybrid events will be communicated within the event details on our website.
